## THE VILLAGE OF DECKERVILLE ORDAINS: Section 1

Pursuant to the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act, Section 6.1, the Village elects to prohibit marihuana establishments within its boundaries.

Effective date: The ordinance requires that it be effective immediately' as it is necessary to regulate persons and property for the preservation of public peace' health, Safety and Welfare under the authority and adopted pursuant to the General Law Village Act, Public Act 3 Of 1895' MCL 61.1 etseq following its authority to regulate persons and property for the Preservation of the public peace' health, Safety and welfare.

Consistency and Repeal: All existing Ordinances or part of Ordinances are to be Interpreted as consistent with this Ordinance and State law. Any Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed Nothing in this Ordinance results in any prohibitions otherwise allowed under the Michigan Medical Marihuana Act, initiated law I of 2008.

Geographic area: This Ordinance shall have the regulatory effect to prohibit marihuana establishments in all geographic areas of the Village of Deckerville to the fullest extent allowed by law.
